Two Task Forces of B-17s consisting of 11 B Combat Wings, and One Task
Force of B-2f 24s consisting of 3 Combat Wings will bomb Frankfurt today.
Total number of aircraft, 660 B-17s, and 180 B-24s. B-17s will be between
23,000 and 27,000 and B-24s at 21,000 ft.
20th and 55th Fighter Gps will give general target support and area support
from R/V to target and then over bomber track as endurance will permit.
P-51s of the 354th Gp will provide top coverfor the 20th and 55th and will

P-47s are covering the Route in and Route out. Spitfires will be maximum giving withdrawal support from South of Brussels to limit of their endurance.

Strong Heavy and light flak will be encountered at the Target area. Heavy flak may be encountered over Brussels and should be avoided.
