

BRIEFING NOTES

TARGET FOR TODAY: Railway Marshalling Yards at Frankfort.  
Attacking force: Twelve boxes of B-17's and three boxes of B-24's.

This command destroys E/A and supports Bombers.  
20th Gp supports 3rd ATF.

Our bombers are Three C.W.'s of B-24's of 22nd Div. Their markings are a circled tail. These are last in line. Two(2) C.W. of bombers fly abreast with interval of 4 minutes between head of one pair and head of following pair.

Gp. Leaders will place emphasis on offensive tactics and will dispatch up to 2/3's strength of unit as necessary to destroy E/A even though some distance from bomber tract. Groups in target area will operate as the disposition of the HUN dictates.

ENEMY ACTION: FLAK--At Aachen on starboard and Bonn on port on way in.  
At Liege on starboard on way home  
Heavy in target area.

FIGHTERS--On route in and out approximately 105 SE and 115 TE can be vectored in.  
In target area approximately 60 SE and 40 TE.

Friendly Action: P-47's will be seen coming out as 20th is on way to R/V.  
P-47's will be escorting bombers as we arrive at R/V.  
P-47's will pick up bombers after first turn after TARGET.  
SPITS WILL pick up bombers Southeast of BRUSSELS.

**P-47's**  
Mustangs are escorting 1st ATF and R/V same spot 35 minutes ahead of 20th.

55th Gp(P-38's) are escorting 2nd ATF and R/V same point 20 minutes ahead of us. May be near target area as we approach.

3rd ATF will echelon to the left after target and may pass 1st. and 2nd ATF on way out.
