3rd. A. T. F. (2 C. W.'s. of the 1st Div. and 2 C. W.'s of the 3rd. Div--
60 B-17's each) attack the railway installations at Frankfurt.

The 1ST and 2ND A. T. F.'s. of 240 B-24's attack No-Ball Targets along the
coast of France during the same operation.

The P-47's provide penetration support to the point at which we R/V with
the 354TH.'s. P-51's. The 55TH Group joins at the Target.
P-47's will provide W/D support.

B-25's, B-26's, Spits, P-47's, Typhoons, Hurricanes and A-20's will be
operating with the B-24's on the Coast of France. Their operations should be
concluded by the time we withdraw.
