I was flying Yellow 2 at 25,000 feet when a FW 190 made a pass at me from astern. Yellow 1 broke left and called me to break. I broke 90° to the left and the FW 190 was turning on Yellow 1. I turned right and made a head on pass at him opening firing out of range and closed to about 100 yards. The E/A starting to break slowly and then sharply right while I was firing. I then turned 180° and tried to rejoin the formation.
