Turned S and swept area out making LF out S of Cayeux at 20,000 feet at approximately 0940. Dropped bombs in channel off N. Foreland. Excellent pattern. No flak. Blue flight investigated T/E bogie S of target area but could not close enough to identify.

Seven planes took off carrying 1-1000 lb. bomb ma and one belly tank. Bombs were fused 1/10-1/100 sec. Eight planes took off without bombs to act as fighter escort. One "bomber" returned early and one "fighter" returned early.

On reaching the continent a solid overcast was encountered. Before reaching the initial point a hole was seen with an A/D visible below. Permission was asked from the Controller to bomb this A/D but was not received. Group stooged around area and finally went to the south where the overcast was not solid but could not find an A/D. After crossing the coast on the way out the bombs were dropped on the bombadier's radio signal and a good pattern was observed in the water.
