## BRIEFING NOTES FOR F.O. #312

The 20th Gp. is furnishing penetration support, target support, and partial withdrawal support to the Front two C.W.s of the 3rd ATF (144 B-24s), bombing a G.A.F station at Gablingen. The bombers will be flying C.W.s abreast and in trail. There altitude at the target will be 18,000 ft.B-24's have circle on tail. There will be 72 B-24s per C.W.

The 1st A.T.F., consisting of 5 C.W.s of the 1st Div. (300 B-17s) will be bombing G.A.F. installations in the same general area.

The 2nd A.T.F., consisting of 4 C.W.s of the 3rd Div. (240 B-17s) will be bombing Fredrichshafen, on Lake Constance.

The 363rd Ftr. Gp., P-51s, will be with the bombers as we make R/V, and we will be relieved by the 78A Gp, P-47s.

The 352A Gp. will be supporting the Last two C.W.s of the 3rd A.TR, which is are bombing Leipheim, im South Nest of our R/V.

All Groups will ensure that an overlap has occurred before relinquishing their support to succeeding Groups.

All Groups will provide definite xat close escort during the bombing run.
