I was flying top cover at 10,000 ft when 55th Ftr Sq went down to strafe. Two E/A took off and weren't noticed by the men on the deck. Thinking that they might clobber some of our boys, I called for cover and went down. By the time I got there they were in a fight with two other P-38s so I stayed above to cover them. The Me-109 was hit and crashed and blew up. The pilot flying FI-P hit the Me-109 on the left wing and he started in for a belly landing. I fired a 90° deflection burst at hig and diesed. He made a beautiful belly landing in a field with probably very little damage to the plane. The pilot took off over a fence, chute and all. I came in and fired a 3 second burst and got strikes all over the plane setting it on fire. I claim One (1) Me-109 destroyed (shared with Lt Schultz of the 55th Ftr Sq).
