LIGHT FLAK (PROBABLY 50 CALIBRE) FIRED AT ALL OF OUR PLANES FROM SHIPS CLOSE INTO SHORE OR FROM SHORE-BASED INSTALLATIONS. MINCEMEAT REPORTS BOGIES COMING INTO THE AREA AS WE LEFT PATROL.
