MAJOR LOBINGIER CRASHED NEAR BOREHAM. HIS LEFT ENGINE WAS OUT. HE MADE A FAST DIVE THRU THE O/C. THEN LEVELED OUT. HE WAS FLYING ALONG IN A NORMAL ATTITUDE AGAIN AND THEN SUDDENLY WENT DOWN AND STRAIGHT IN. THE PLANE EXPLODED. NO CHUTE SEEN.
