- A. 77th Fighter Squadron, 20th Fighter Group, Captain Morris leading.

  - In 0856 at 24,000 feet at Egmond. R/V with B-24s of 2nd Div. at 0948 at 24,000 feet at Allendorf. Bombers strung out but in good formation within small groups of 12. W/D and LF out 1144 at 14,000 feet at Egmond.
  - Intense heavy flak N of Brunswick, meager inaccurate heavy flak at ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ Hannover. No E/a. B-17s of 3rd Div. with P-51s escort in target area. P-47s also seen.
  - Very much road activity and traffic on main highways running north and south in Arnheim, Utrecht area; many big vans but mostly passenger cars.
- J. One (1) Gas Truck Destroyed 8 miles N of Arheim, Lt. Moncrieff.  
Two (2) Trucks damaged - Utrecht, Lt. Moncrieff.

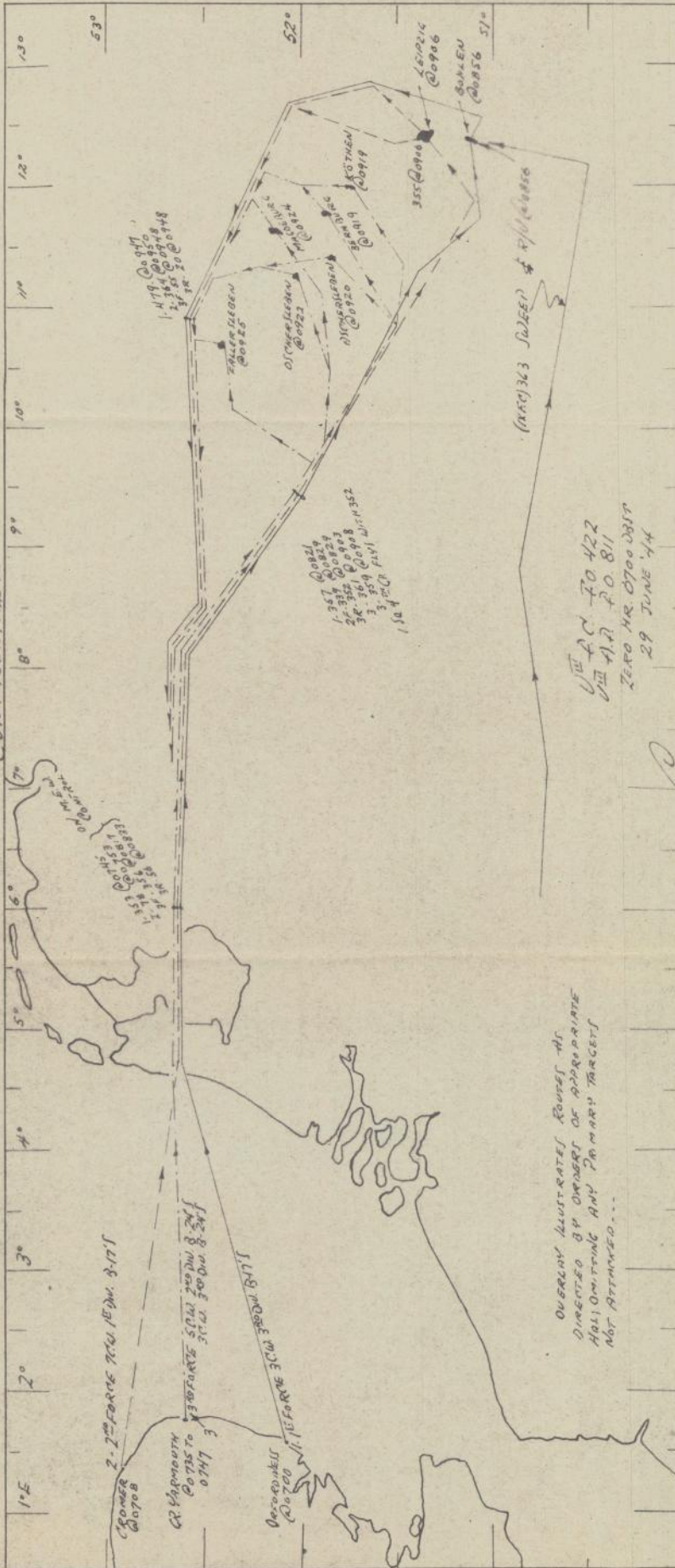
Flak: Some flak at Hannover
