- A. 55TH FIGHTER SQUADRON, COL. WILSON LEADING
- B. TIME UP 0344, TIME DOWN 0755 HOURS
- C. 16 A/C OFF
- D. THRU F. NIL
- G. SQUADRON MADE L/F OUT 0423 AT 3,000 FEET. IN AREA 0430 HOURS. W/D 0610 HOURS AND PROCEEDED TO GRANVILLE. WEATHER WAS DOWN TO 200 FEET SO SQUADRON CAME HOME, MAKING L/F IN 0722 HOURS 3,000 FEET.

FLAK FROM OUR BOATS IN THE CHANNEL WAS HEAVIEST EVER SEEN BY MEMBERS ON THE FLIGHT.
