S T A T E M E N T

I was in the Control Tower at AAF Station F-131, and saw Major JOHN G. WILKINS, O-22851, take off on the mission on 7 November 1943 and report the following facts. He did not take-off on the mission in question until seven (7) minutes after the last ship of his formation, which was the last one, had taken-off. He raced around the perimeter taxi-way, after having, apparently, some trouble getting started, and took off on the wrong runway. This is to say that he took-off by himself after the other ships had been gone for seven (7) minutes. After he passed out of sight at this Station, he was not seen or heard from anymore. There was neither radio or visual contact with him again.
